

**THE INTERNATIONAL CHESS FESTIVAL FOR KIDS «ANATOLY KARPOV OPEN»  
REGULATIONS**

**MOSCOW 2019**

## 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The regulations determine conditions and procedures for the International chess festival for kids «ANATOLY KARPOV OPEN» (hereinafter the Tournament) during the festival «Aeroflot open 2020»

## 2. PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES

The Tournament is held to:

- popularize chess among kids and teenagers;
- improve chess skills and qualifications of young players.

## 3. TIME AND VENUE

The Tournament is to be held in Moscow from 18 (arrival) to 29 (departure) February, 2020.

The Tournament's venue: 4 Vtoroy Selskohoziaystvenny proezd, Moscow, Russia – Anatoly Karpov's international center of chess education in the Moscow City University.

## 4. ORGANIZATION

The general supervision of the event is carried out by the International Chess Education limited with the support of the Association of chess federations.

The direction of the Tournament itself is assigned to a panel of arbiters.

## 5. PARTICIPATION

Boys and girls 2008 year of birth and younger are allowed to participate (if they do not have any health contraindications and pay the tournament fee).

## 6. RULES, PROCEDURES AND CONDITIONS

The Tournament contains 9 tournaments in the following age categories:

Open A1 – 2008 - 2009 y.o.b.;

Open B1 - 2010 – 2011 y.o.b.;

Open C1 – 2012 y.o.b. and younger.

RAPID:

Open A2 – 2008 - 2009 y.o.b.;

Open B2 - 2010 – 2011 y.o.b.;

Open C2 – 2012 y.o.b. and younger.

Blitz:

Open A3 – 2008 - 2009 y.o.b.;

Open B3 - 2010 – 2011 y.o.b.;

Open C3 – 2012 y.o.b. and younger.

The tournaments are held according to the chess sport rules, approved by order No.1087 of the Ministry of Sports of Russia on 19.12.2017 and compatible with FIDE chess rules. The behavior of the participants is regulated by the actual Statement on sanctions in chess.

Chess tournaments are organized under the Swiss system with 7 rounds with a use of a computer chess pairing program Swiss-Manager. Time control for each game: 60 minutes plus 30 seconds per each move starting from the first (according to Bronstein).

Rapid tournaments are organized under the Swiss system with 9 rounds with a use of a computer chess pairing program Swiss-Manager. Time control for each game: 10 minutes plus 5 seconds per each move starting from the first (according to Bronstein).

Blitz tournaments are organized under the Swiss system with 9 rounds with a use of a computer chess pairing program Swiss-Manager. Time control for each game: 5 minutes plus 3 seconds per each move starting from the first (according to Bronstein).

## 7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Appeals Committee consists of 3 main and 2 substitute members. Each appeal has to be forwarded to the chairman of the Appeals Committee within one hour after the end of the tour. Each participant submitting the appeal has to pay a deposit of 2000 rubles, which returns when the appeal is solved.

## 8. DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

The standing is determined according to the number of points scored. In the case of equality of points the standing is defined by the additional indicators in the Swiss system:

- The Buchholz coefficient;
- The number of victories;
- The result private meeting;
- The Buchholz truncated coefficient.

## 9. AWARDING SYSTEM

Boys winners get the cups, limited medals and other gifts.

An award is also a participation in International chess festival «Vila de Platja d'Aro» 2020 and an attendance to Anatoly Karpov's International chess camp.

Girls winners get the cups, limited medals and other gifts.
